## Frontera Healthcare Celebrates Fredericksburg Behavioral Health Open House and Ribbon Cutting

The space also features a dedicated area for play therapy, allowing for a full range of services for all.

Frontera Behavioral Health provides a wide scope of services, including individual and family counseling, play therapy, substance use counseling, and psychiatric services. Both in-person and virtual sessions are available for patients as young as four years old through adulthood. With this expansion, Frontera is proud to meet growing behavioral health needs and provide critical resources for the community.

The Fredericksburg Chamber of Commerce joined the ribbon cutting, along with officials from Methodist Hill Country Hospital, representatives of the Texas Wine Auction Foundation. The event highlighted the strong community collaboration that made this expansion possible.
